CAMS is a suicide-specific therapeutic framework, emphasizing five core components of collaborative clinical care (over 10-12 sessions/3 months)

Component I Collaborative Assessment of Suicidal Risk Component II Collaborative Treatment Planning Attend treatment reliably as scheduled over the next three months Reduce access to lethal means
